- High School Diploma/GED
- Must have own transportation
- Must be available during school hours
 - Needed for school year
 - Same hours of availability each day Monday through Friday
 - Approximately 24 hours per week, depending upon assignment
- Must successfully complete mandatory training program – dates to be determined
